## What to Bring to the Clinic

- \* **A healthy rideable horse** (*unless you are only doing ground work with a young horse, keeping in mind this is not a colt starting clinic*)
  - \* **A rope halter and lead rope** (*the lead rope should 12-14 feet long and made of yacht rope. I will have loaners if you need a set.*)
  - \* **Head stall with smooth mouth ring snaffle bit, or riding halter is recommended.** (Bits can be purchased at the clinic for cost)  
*Please do not bring tie downs, "Magic Bits", or any other gadgets cause I will just throw them away.*
  - \* **Appropriate clothes for horse training**, including jeans or riding pants, smooth soled boots for riding, hat or riding helmet, and a jacket or sun block incase the weather changes.
  - \* **A chair**, or something to sit on.
  - \* **A bucket to water your horse** (water for horses at arena), and something to drink for yourself. Water and
